

TH SPECIAL KITCHEN ISSUE

ALYCE DRENTH HAS AN EXUBERANT MOTTO for kitchen design: "Function, function, function; then make it beautiful!" In this new home, in the Bathurst-Glencairn neighbourhood, she was given free rein to do just that.
